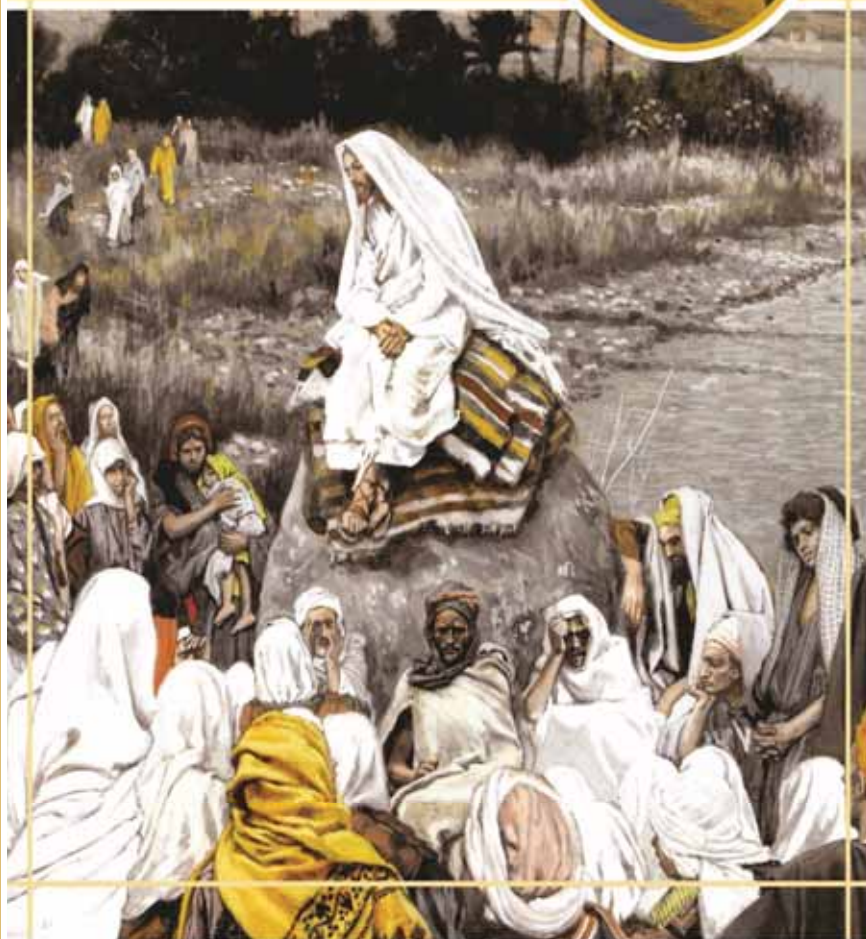

**TREASURES FROM OUR TRADITION**

The American Revolution cleared the way for freedom of religion in the former colonies, since the colonies had always been a more religiously tolerant place than the old country. Even so, colonial laws restricted the practice of the Catholic faith, and just as in England, Americans who desired to be priests or nuns had to go to the Netherlands or France. As political storm clouds gathered in France, an American woman, Mother Bernardina Matthews, the prioress of the Hoogstraeten Carmel in Holland, made a brave move. With two other American nuns, her nieces, and a Dutch sister, she came to Port Tobacco, Maryland, in 1790. Within twenty years the community had grown to twenty, although by 1823 their farm failed and they had to move to Baltimore and open a school. The Carmelite order requires contemplation and cloister, so in time the school was closed. The Port Tobacco land had long since been sold, but in 1976 a community of nuns was able to return thanks to loyal neighbors who had worked for forty years for their restoration. Today, our original American convent is fully alive in prayer, hard work, and strong community.

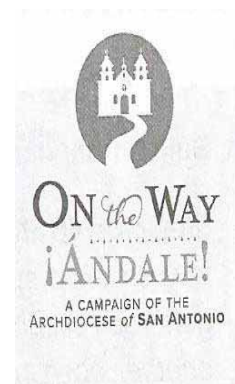

Next weekend will mark the official start for the **On the Way—¡Ándale!** Capital Campaign at St. Margaret Mary parish. This major fundraising effort will address some of our parish needs: repair Fair Avenue parking lot, \$110,000; New Technology Center, \$25,000; Renovate bathrooms in Education Building, \$25,000; Repair Activity Center, \$50,000; Repair and Update Sacristy, \$10,000; Update Sanctuary at St. Catherine Mission, \$15,000 and archdiocesan needs including seed money for the establishment of new parishes in areas of growth, funds in support of the social services Catholic Charities renders to over 230,000 people a year, the establishment of a pilgrimage center at Mission Concepción, support for lay ministry formation, the modernization of Assumption Seminary to support priestly formation, the renovation of Catholic Schools across the archdiocese, and strengthening Campus Ministry at Texas A&M San Antonio and UTSA.



The preparation phase of the capital campaign began last fall. The archbishop and a leadership team of campaign general chairs have been meeting with major gift donors for the last several months to provide the **On the Way—¡Ándale!** Capital Campaign with momentum. As we join other parishes in participating in the pilot wave of this important effort, it is with great joy that we report the campaign has already secured gifts and pledges! It is now our turn to continue to great momentum they started.

We will be officially kicking off the **On the Way—¡Ándale!** Capital Campaign at all Masses next weekend July 28th and 29th. It is an exciting time to be a Catholic in South Central Texas!
